Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 5.4% since 2018, growing by 15,867. Population is expected to increase by 4.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 14,780.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 2.2% in Cumberland County, ME from 209,148 to 213,847. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 2.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.9% to 64.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **30.7% of Cumberland County, ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% above the national average), and **8.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Oct 2024 Labor Force Breakdown










Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Cumberland County, ME had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.54%, increasing from 2.29% 5 years before.






Millennials

Cumberland County, ME has 64,238 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 63,034.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Cumberland County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 93,651 people 55 or older, while there are 107,566 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Cumberland County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 129,202 racially diverse people, while there are 35,848 here.




Veterans

Cumberland County, ME has 0.97 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP



In 2023, there were 4,637 graduates in Cumberland County, ME. This pipeline has remained stable (neither grown nor shrunk) over the last 5 years.
