


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.1% since 2018, growing by 1,217. Population is expected to increase by 2.5% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,012.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 2.1% in Knox County, ME from 21,860 to 21,397. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 6.6%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.3% to 58.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **24.4% of Knox County, ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.3% above the national average), and **7.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Fishing.










Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Knox County, ME had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.92%, increasing from 2.79% 5 years before.




Veterans

Retirement risk is high in Knox County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 12,370 people 55 or older, while there are 17,788 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Knox County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 17,066 racially diverse people, while there are 2,341 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration




