
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.1% since 2018, growing by 2,111. Population is expected to increase by 5.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,947.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 2.5% in Lincoln County, ME from 14,400 to 14,756. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 2.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 55.9% to 52.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **24.5% of Lincoln County, ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.4% above the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Grocery Stores.


Oct 2024 Labor Force Breakdown










Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Lincoln County, ME had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.82%, decreasing from 2.83% 5 years before.




Lincoln County, ME has 5,617 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,418.




Veterans

Lincoln County, ME has 3,086 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,855.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 11,021 people 55 or older, while there are 16,801 here.




Violent Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings






