
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.4% since 2018, growing by 942. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,359.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.9% in Waldo County, ME from 14,913 to 14,629. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 6.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.2% to 58.5% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 20.5% of Waldo County, ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (0.7% below the
 national average), and 8.8% hold an Associate's Degree (the same as the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Management of Companies and Enterprises, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends




Waldo County, ME had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.82%, decreasing from 3.05% 5 years before.







Millennials

Waldo County, ME has 6,667 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,253.






Waldo County, ME has 2,524 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,058.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration











