Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.1% since 2018, growing by 12,545. Population is expected to increase by 5.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 11,548.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 6.7% in York County, ME from 85,912 to 91,690. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 2.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.8% to 62.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **21.5% of York County, ME residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.3% above the national average), and **11.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Federal Government, Civilian, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Oct 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




York County, ME had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.63%, increasing from 2.60% 5 years before.






Veterans

York County, ME has 16,103 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 11,092.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in York County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 65,986 people 55 or older, while there are 84,109 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in York County, ME. The national average for an area this size is 91,035 racially diverse people, while there are 15,886 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 1,651 graduates in York County, ME. This pipeline has shrunk by 21% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Social Work" (Master's or Higher), "Osteopathic Medicine/Osteopathy" (Master's or Higher), and "Public Health, General" (Master's or Higher).
